In March, 2016, in order to further strengthen the training of foreign affairs cadres, China Diplomatic Academy was launched, In conjunction with CFAU, it created an integrated framework of diplomat training, higher education and academic research, and formed a talent supply system to support the sustained development of major country diplomacy with Chinese characteristics.

China Diplomatic Academy has established at a preliminary level a multi-level, multi-channel and three-dimensional training system. In terms of diplomatic training, it provides a six-month to one-year on-the-spot training for newly recruited diplomats; trains the newly-appointed diplomats at councilor level in policy theory, leadership art, crisis management and psychological adjustment; arranges practical training for high-level diplomats who serve, for the first time, as chiefs of mission and first staff members of Chinese embassies or consulates. In addition, it has supported off-the-job training or offered lectures, such as seminars on diplomatic theory and skills and lectures on national conditions.

To supplement traditional training forms, the China Diplomatic Academy has set up a network-training platform to improve the comprehensive ability and professional level of diplomats by means of live video broadcasting and recording. It has also become the main form of training in the post-epidemic era.

Regarding the training concerned with foreign affairs and other relevant issues, the China Diplomatic Academy launched the "Local Classroom of China Diplomatic Academy" to deliver training to local foreign affairs cadres. It organizes the Seminar for Young German Diplomats Visiting China and the Special Workshop for Young European Officials. China Diplomatic Academy has also established contacts and cooperative relations

with diplomatic training institutions of the United States, Russia, Germany, France and international organizations such as the United Nations. China Foreign Affairs University has signed cooperation agreements with Mexican Foreign Affairs Universities and other institutions.

The year 2021 marks an epoch-making year for China. We are celebrating the centenary of the Communist Party of China, and China's diplomacy will be embarked on a new journey and usher in new development. We will, in light of the historical trend, actively promote new international relations, and carry forward the common values of peace, development, fairness, justice, democracy and freedom of all humankind.
